Local Crime Information

The following crimes are of concern to the Manningham Police.

- Recently, residential burglars favoured Templestowe, Bulleen and Doncaster East. Police have made several arrests in relation to this offending. Mail and package theft occurred at apartment complexes in Doncaster East, Templestowe and Bulleen. Put a padlock on your letterbox. If you won't be home, send parcels to a parcel locker, PO Box, or other collection point.
- There were thefts and attempted thefts from vehicles across Manningham (except for Warrandyte and Wonga Park). Vehicles known to store tools are often targeted, whether they're in a gated driveway on a residential street in Templestowe, or in a secure underground apartment carpark in Doncaster. Thieves jump fences! No matter where your car is parked or how 'secure' you think the location is, always lock it and remove any valuables.
- There were only a few cars stolen from around Manningham recently. Offenders stole car keys from inside homes to steal a car from a carport in Templestowe and from a driveway in Bulleen. A car was stolen from a shopping centre carpark in Doncaster East, and there was an attempt to steal a car parked at a shopping centre carpark in Doncaster. A car parked on the street in Doncaster was stolen using keys left inside the car. Never leave keys inside your car. Memorise your car registration; the sooner you report your car stolen, the sooner police can flag it as stolen.
- Around 1am on the 25 October, two men tried unsuccessfully to break into a liquor store in Templestowe. A restaurant in Donvale was broken into in the early hours of 23 October, and the offender stole iPads, the tips jar and soft drinks. A Scout Hall in Templestowe had a trailer loaded with camping equipment stolen by unknown offender between 12 and 16 October. Eight Things to do Before Your Holiday

There are things that you can do before you go on holiday that can discourage burglars and make your home more secure while you are away.

- Cancel newspapers and other regular deliveries.
- Put a hold on mail at your local Post Office.
- Cut the lawns so they don't look unkempt.
- Make sure the garage and sheds are locked.
- Fit time switches on some lights and radios so they turn on at various times.
- Ask your neighbour to keep an eye on things.
- Complete an "Absence from Residence" form at Doncaster Police Station or on-line at: https://www.police.vic.gov.au/home-and-property#register-absence-from-residence
- Make a final check to see that all appliances are switched off, and doors and windows are locked in the house, garage and any sheds.
