The TAE40122 Certificate IV in Training and Assessment qualification has superseded the TAE40116 Certificate IV in Training and Assessment qualification and has been deemed equivalent to and the successor of the TAE40116 qualification. Although we have chosen to use the term "upgrade," it is important to note that it is not technically an upgrade. The TAE40122 is, in fact, a successor to the TAE40116, resulting in equivalent qualifications, with the change being in the units within the qualifications.

Our upgrade program is designed specifically for experienced VET Trainers and Assessors who hold the TAE40116 version of the Certificate IV in Training and Assessment and have accrued at least two years of training experience delivering nationally recognised qualifications or units of competency within the past four years.

Entry Requirements

Our upgrade program is specifically for experienced VET Trainers and Assessors who hold TAE40116 version of the Certificate IV in Training and Assessment and have accrued at least 2 years of training experience, delivering nationally recognised qualifications or units of competency, within the past 4 years. Please note: If you have not been teaching nationally recognised qualifications or units of competency you will not be eligible for this upgrade.

Appropriate language, literacy and numeracy skills are required. Moderate computer skills are also required.

Students will require access to a computer or device that can connect to the internet and internet access.

Application Procedure

Prospective students are required to participate in a Pre-Training Review to determine their suitability to participate in the program. They will be required to provide evidence of their TAE40116 Certificate IV in training and assessment certificate and transcript.
